

# Our storm net

In order to ensure peace of mind and peace of mind in view of a possible flood, MegaSecur offers you the storm net to keep the barrier on the ground during strong winds.

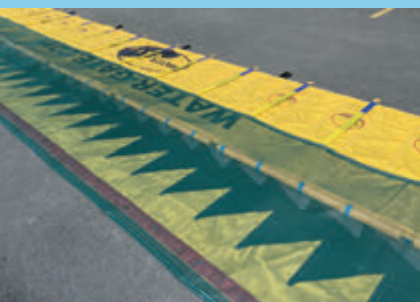
If you are installing in strong winds, MegaSecur has developed a system that is installed on the barrier and prevents it from moving even with winds of more than 90 km/hour, tested in a wind tunnel. This system is a small-mesh net tight enough to prevent strong winds from entering below this fabric and displacing the water barrier, but also, this net is sufficiently permeable to let water easily enter the barrier.

After a good amount of water has started to enter the barrier, the pressure of this water will hold the barrier down and force the storm sail to stretch. At this time, someone will have to release the storm sail held by scratch strips located at the back of the barrier. Located behind the barrier. This operation is easy, fast and does not require great effort.



1. Unroll, fully unfold and attach all Water-Gate water barriers.

2. Attach floats as shown along the entire length to protect against winds.



3. Install the storm sails on the barriers. This sail is held firmly by nails on the ground.

4. After a fair amount of flood water has entered the barrier and the storm sail restricts the opening of the barrier, you will only need to remove the hook and loop fasteners to release the barriers from the storm sails.
